## **WHAT is the Edmonton Public Teachers Charity Trust Fund?**

It is a fund of money assembled through the voluntary charitable donations of teachers who agree to contribute 1/2 of 1% of salary (average donation is approximately \$37/month) through payroll deductions. These funds are disbursed annually under the supervision of the Local's Donations Committee.

## **WHY participate?**

- Donations are Income Tax deductible and receipted on T4 slips, reducing paperwork at tax time.
- Profiles the involvement of teachers in their community.
- Provides a ready response to telephone and door-to-door solicitations, "I already gave at the office".
- Ensures donations go directly to the selected agencies by eliminating the administrative fee.

## **WHERE do our donations go?**

The Local's focus is on charities that have the greatest impact on the young people we work with. Last year, donations were made to charities screened and selected by the Donations Committee. A complete list of last year's recipients is available on the reverse of this form.
