

Murray Jampolsky Scholarship Guidelines and Criteria

November 16, 2018

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Edmonton Public Teachers Local No. 37 offers a scholarship in memory of Dr. Murray Jampolsky, a former Executive member of the Local and President of the Alberta Teachers' Association. While serving his colleagues through his work with the ATA, Murray Jampolsky completed a Master's degree and later a PhD. To encourage other teachers to follow Dr. Jampolsky's example of service to colleagues and ongoing individual professional growth, the Local established the Murray Jampolsky Scholarship.

GENERAL FRAME OF REFERENCE

- The Local shall offer annually a scholarship or scholarships not to exceed a total amount of \$6,000 in memory of Dr. Murray Jampolsky.
- Teachers who are members of the Local are eligible to apply for the scholarship; however, no teacher may receive the scholarship for more than two years consecutively; and no more than \$6,000 in their career.
- The applicant(s) must state their intention to continue a career in education in Alberta.
- The scholarship(s) is/are payable upon proof of enrolment in a TQS recognized program at a university or post-secondary institution.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION
4:00 PM, JANUARY 9, 2019

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. The criteria for selection shall be based on the evaluation of professional service to colleagues through:
 - a) Service provided to the Edmonton Public Teachers Local No, 37 and/or service provided to the provincial Alberta Teachers' Association (ATA) (up to 50% awarded).
 - b) Other professional activities (up to 25% awarded).
 - c) Personal professional growth (up to 25% awarded).
2. The application shall only be recommended providing the total score awarded is at least 60% based on the average of the scores assigned by each voting member of the Selection Committee.
3. The recommendation of the Selection Committee shall be placed before the Executive Committee of the Local who will make the decision as to the recipient(s) of the scholarship.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee shall consist of:

1. The Local Table Officers,
2. Two members of the Council of School Representatives, and
3. One member of the Local office Executive staff (non-voting).
