- Hazard Controls are broken into three main categories: Engineering, Administrative and Personal Protective Equipment.
- These categories are considered as a hierarchy based on level of effectiveness.
- Engineering controls function at the point of the hazard (e.g. a guardrail on a roof, an autoscrubber)
- Administrative controls function in the path between the hazard and the employee (e.g. procedures, training, signs, etc.)
- Personal protective equipment controls function at the point of the employee (e.g. gloves, masks, etc.)
- Contact your assigned OHS Consultant for clarification or questions.
