WHAT is the Edmonton Public Teachers Charity Trust Fund?

It is a fund of money collected through the voluntary charitable donations of teachers. These funds are disbursed annually under the supervision of the Local's Donations Committee.

WHY participate?

- **Donations are Income Tax deductible and receipted on T4 slips** (if you choose to sign up for payroll deductions), reducing paperwork at tax time.
- Profiles the involvement of teachers in their community.
- Provides a ready response to telephone and door-to-door solicitations, "I already gave at the office".
- Ensures donations go directly to the selected agencies by eliminating the administrative fee.

WHERE do our donations go?

The Local's focus is on charities that have the greatest impact on the young people we work with. A complete list of last year's recipients is available on the reverse of this form.

HOW do I contribute?

There are now two ways to donate!

1. If you are not currently a contributor and would like to sign up for payroll deductions (1/2 of 1% of salary - average is approximately \$37/month) complete and submit the form below. OR
2. You can now make monthly or one-time donations directly through CanadaHelps.org (by using the QR code or following this link <https://www.canadahelps.org/en/dn/77919>), and instantly receive your tax receipt.
